What is Irlen Syndrome/Scotopic Sensitivity Syndrome?

Irlen Syndrome or Scotopic Sensitivity Syndrome(SSS) is a sensitivity to light that can significantly interfere with reading and writing activities. It can lower test scores and impair a person's ability to function in school and work situations. It can co-exist with dyslexia, learning disabilities, attention deficit disorder, autism, and some emotional or behavioral disturbances. Irlen Syndrome/SSS can not be diagnosed using standard educational, psychoeducational, or speech and language tests. Fortunately, this syndrome is very easy to diagnose and treat. Learn how to diagnose and correct Irlen Syndrome using the Irlen Screening Method and Irlen Colored Overlays.

How do you screen for Irlen Syndrome?

The Irlen Screening Process is efficient and economical. The testing and remediation can be administered individually in 30-60 minutes, and results are immediately known. Irlen testing can be administered alone or as a part of a test battery. The Irlen Method is currently being used in schools throughout the world as well as in clinic and private practice settings.

How do you become trained to administer the Irlen Screening Test?

To become a Certified Irlen Screener, you must participate in a two-day workshop with a Certified Irlen Trainer. Day 2 is a practicum in which participants administer, score, and interpret Irlen screenings with actual clients. Certification as an Irlen Screener does not permit you to train others as Irlen Screeners.

Who qualifies to be trained to screen for Irlen Syndrome?

Educators, Reading Specialists, Special Education Specialists, School nurses, Psychologists, Speech Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Counselors, Teachers, and Diagnosticians can qualify to be trained as Irlen Screeners. Certain other professionals may also qualify on a limited basis. To register for the Training Workshop submit a completed application form, a professional resume and training fee. If you are not accepted for the training workshop, the entire fee will be returned.

Costs?
